

Retirees 65 & Over with Medicare Part A & B

Medicare beneficiaries can obtain up to eight Covid-19 tests per calendar month from participating pharmacies and health care providers for the duration of the COVID-19 public health emergency.

Medicare Members should show their red, white, and blue Medicare card at a participating pharmacy or provider, not their Aetna Medicare Advantage card. Pharmacies and healthcare providers will bill Medicare directly to allow Medicare beneficiaries to receive tests at no cost to them.

SPOUSAL CARVE OUT

If an employee's spouse is eligible for health coverage under his/her employer sponsored plan, the spouse is NOT eligible for coverage under the County's medical plan. Annually, retirees will attest to whether their spouse is eligible for health coverage when enrolling in benefits.

In order for a retiree to cover his/her dependents through Shelby County Government's health insurance plan, the retiree must be covered under the plan. Shelby County Government offers health coverage to eligible retirees and their dependents, not to dependents only. This does not affect spousal benefits for retirees who currently have health coverage.



MEDICARE INFORMATION

As a participant in Shelby County Government's health insurance plan, it is a requirement that retirees and their dependent(s) obtain Medicare Part A & Part B approximately 3 months prior to turning 65. It is a requirement, if eligible, that any retiree or dependent who is currently disabled, or becomes disabled, must also apply for Medicare Part A & B.

Ingredients

2 tablespoons olive oil

1 cup fresh or frozen corn kernels

½ cup diced green bell pepper

½ cup diced red bell pepper

½ cup diced onion

1 5-ounce package baby spinach

2 ½ cups shredded cooked chicken breast

1 8-ounce pouch red or green enchilada sauce, such as Frontera

1 ¼ cups prepared fresh salsa

8 5- or 6-inch corn tortillas, cut into 1-inchthick strips

1 ½ cups shredded reduced-fat Cheddar cheese

1 cup coarsely chopped grape tomatoes ¼ cup chopped fresh cilantro

¼ cup matchstick-cut radishes

Directions Instructions

Checklist Step 1

Preheat oven to 350°F.

Step 2

Heat oil in a large ovenproof skillet, such as cast-iron. Add corn, green and red peppers, and onion; cook, stirring occasionally, until charred, 7 to 10 minutes. Gradually add spinach in batches; cook, stirring frequently, until wilted, 1 to 2 minutes.

Step 3

Stir in chicken, enchilada sauce, and salsa until combined. Gently stir in tortilla strips. Sprinkle with cheese. Transfer to the oven and bake until bubbly, about 15 minutes.

Step 4

Top the casserole with tomatoes, cilantro, and radishes.

Discrepancies must be reported within 60 days of the pay date in order to receive a credit for any incorrect changes.




