2023 FEDERAL TAX WITHHOLDING CHANGES

The IRS released a revised Form W-4P (Withholding Certificate for Periodic Pension or Annuity Payments) that includes substantial changes to the federal tax withholding elections.

These changes are effective January 1, 2023. Shelby County retirees and beneficiaries who already receive ongoing payments and who do not wish to make changes to their federal tax withholding elections are not required to file a new form.

Our system has been updated to convert your 2022 withholding elections to the new 2023 calculation method. However, if you wish to make changes to your withholding status, on or after January 1, 2023, you will be required to use the new 2023 W-4P form. To obtain the new 2023 W-4P form, visit www.irs.gov or you may contact our office.

PLEASE BE ADVISED: Shelby County Retirement System staff members are not tax advisors and cannot advise or assist you with completion of the new 2023 W-4P form. For assistance, please contact your tax professional or the IRS for guidance.
